

#### What you will need

- M Red sugarpaste
- Pink sugarpaste
- M Small amount of black and white sugarpaste
- Red colouring (gel/paste)
- White dust/powder
- A fine paintbrush
- Water
- 1x cocktail stick/skewer
- M Small ball tool
- M Small sharp knife







Start out with a ball of red sugarpaste.

Put your hands on either side of it and start to roll it back and forth (as pictured) keeping the bottom on your worktop at all times.

As your rolling bring your hands up until you have a type of bell shape with a flat bottom.

Insert your cocktail stick so that about 1.5cm is visible.











Next is Peppa's head. Start out with a ball of baby pink sugarpaste. In the same way we kept the red ball on the worktop we are going to roll the pink, but this time between our two little fingers.

As you start to create a flat snout, apply abit more pressure with your fingers and the snout will get longer!





Flip the head over to reveal your flat snout!



Push the head onto the cocktail stick & stick with water if you prefer



Peppa has a head!





Roll out a thin sausage of pink and cut out 2 pieces the same size. These are going to be legs.



Place your strips into the position you would like her legs to be



Squish Peppa's body onto the legs.
Use water to stick if necessary.





Roll out another thin sausage of pink, this time for arms.



Gently roll the end of the arm to a point with your finger







Take a small piece of pink and roll it gently at either end to make it pointed.



Lay your smallest pointed piece down on the worktop and lay the arm onto it.
All the pointed parts should be at one end



Curl the ends in the same direction to create the hand/fingers



Stick the arms in any position you like with a little water.

Follow the steps again to make a second arm.

To make Peppa wave you can insert a small wire into her arm for support and then into her body but please make sure you notfly the recipient/customer about the supports inside!











She needs a tail!

Roll out yet more pink in a thin sausage and gently roll one end again to create a point.

Start to create a spiral by twisting it, the more you twist..the tighter the curl!

Attach the tail to Peppa's cute little butt with some water:)



Almost finished with the pink!
Create 2 small teardrop shapes and stick them to Peppa's head to create her ears.









Then create 2 small black teardrop shapes for her shoes. Stick these to the end of her legs with a little water.





Roll 2 small white balls and stick them to her head with water



Flatten them down and smooth with a ball tool



Do the same with smaller balls of black for pupils.





Combine a small amount of your red colouring with the white powder

and water to make pink paint. Paint on round cheeks.



Add more red to your paint mixture to make a deeper pink/red and paint on a cute little smile and nostrils.



Stand back and admire the little Peppa you just made!



## Done

Other members of Peppa's family are all done in the same way.

Just take note of extra's such as glasses for Daddy,

eyelashes for Mummy etc and also the shape of their bodies.
